

According to one study, there are between 450-500 million atheists in the world (about 7 percent).

A 2014 Pew survey found that 3.1 percent of the US identifies as atheist. But in the same year 9 percent agreed with the statement "Do not believe in God" while 2 percent agreed with the statement "Do not know if they believe in a God." In 1994 it was only 0.034%.

SHARING JESUS WITH... ATHEISTS

WHAT IS ATHEISM?

Atheism is the belief that God does not exists. The word atheist comes from the Latin a-theism "no God." Atheism is usually a sub category of humanism, a system of thought where the importance of only humans rather than divine.

Many like atheist George Smith have tried to make atheism the default position by saying, "I just lack a belief in God." This self-refuting as it makes a statement about God.

What is an Agnostic?

An agnostic is someone who does not know if God exists or not. It is someone who takes a position less firm than an atheist. They may or may not be open to the existence of God. The word agnostic comes from the Latin a-gnosis meaning "no knowledge." Agnosticism can either be expressed as two forms. **Soft agnosticism**, says "we do not know if God exists." **Hard agnosticism**, says "we cannot know that God exists." Agnosticism is self-defeating. To claim that "one cannot know anything about God" is to say something about God.

The American Atheist Creed

An atheists accepts that only in a knowledge of himself and a knowledge of his fellow man can find the understanding that will help to a life of fulfillment."

What do atheists believe about the universe?

Atheists believe that the universe is **eternal**. It has always been in existence. A beginning implies it has a Beginner. Our current universe is 13.8 Billion years old. SHARING JESUS WITH ATHEISTS

General Tips

As always be kind and gracious. Control your temper and do not let yourself become frustrated in your conversations.

Be willing to befriend and listen to the atheist. Ask questions about what they personally believe. Not everyone is the same.

Engage people out of an act of love and not a desire to win an argument or make yourself look good, or them bad.

Specific Tips

Determine if they are really seeking truth and complement them if they are. Try to determine what is the reason they are atheists. Is it a heart or head issue? Are they struggling with understanding an intellectual concept or are they just in a rebellious state in life not wanting God to have a divine hold in their life. Address the issue that seems to be the source of their "unbelief."

Atheists can unintentional **steamroll** over you with multiple areas where they disagree with Christianity. Don't let them. Ask them what one area they would like to discuss first, what they think is the most important reason. Focus on that issue first.

Use the **Pillars of Christianity** from week 3. Work up through the pillars with them using apologetics. It would not make sense to use the Bible as proof of God if they do not believe in God yet.

Show how **evolution is F.L.A.W.E.D.** and does not explain the world the way it actually is and how people think and live.

Give specific reasons why we believe the **universe had a beginning**. The Big Bang Singularity, Background Radiation, Red shift, Philosophically, try counting backwards to negative infinity.

Point out the inconsistencies of atheists. Many atheists have **a sense of justice or an "ought"** that they internally feel life should be like but their own worldview denies them this actuality. Example: The oppression of women and the LGBTQ community.


Example: Take their wallet (not really) don't let them complain. Example: Point out Slavery, Nazi Germany, events in the past...

Be ready to suggest books, YouTube videos, articles that you can share or give them to help them do their own research/study.

Point out that Christianity is both reasonable and logical.

Avoid arguments about God's character, what he did and didn't do, and focus on Jesus life his death and resurrection from the dead.

Don't be afraid to say, "I don't know." You can research and find out.



The Twelve Points That Show Christianity Is True.

- 1. Truth about reality is knowable.
- 2. The opposite of true is false.
- 3. It is true that the theistic God exists. This is evidenced by the:
 - a. Beginning of the universe (Cosmological Argument)
 - b. Design of the universe (Teleological Argument/Anthropic Principle)
 - c. Design of life (Teleological Argument)
 - d. Moral Law (Moral Argument)
- 4. If God exists, then miracles are possible.
- 5. Miracles can be used to confirm a message from God (i.e., as acts of God to confirm a word from God).
- 6. The New Testament is historically reliable. This is evidenced by:
 - a. Early testimony
 - b. Eyewitness testimony
 - c. Uninvented (authentic) testimony
 - d. Eyewitnesses who were not deceived
- 7. The New Testament says Jesus claimed to be God.
- 8. Jesus' claim to be God was miraculously confirmed by:
 - a. His fulfillment of many prophecies about himself;
 - b. His sinless life and miraculous deeds;
 - c. His prediction and accomplishment of his resurrection.
- 9. Therefore, Jesus is God.
- 10. Whatever Jesus (who is God) teaches is true.
- 11. Jesus taught that the Bible is the Word of God.
- 12. Therefore, it is true that the Bible is the Word of God (and anything opposed to it is false).
